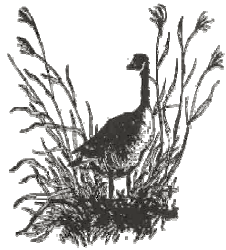


Goose Lake Prairie State Natural Area



The Park is open from Sunrise to Sunset.

- While groups of 25 or more are welcome and encouraged to use the park's facilities, they are required to register in advance with the site office to avoid crowding or scheduling conflicts.
- There can be no motorized vehicles or bikes on park trails.
- Dog sledding is not allowed on park trails.
- There is no provision for boating on the park lakes, except for fishing in Heidecke Lake.
- No alcohol is allowed in the park.
- At least one responsible adult must accompany each group of 15 minors.
- Pets must be kept on leashes at all times.
- Actions by nature can result in closed roads and other facilities. Please call ahead to the park office before you make your trip.
- We hope you enjoy your stay. Remember, take only memories, and leave only footprints.
